CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE

As with any painted metal surface, the appearance of the **enzie** Spiral Stair will be optimised, by the implementation of suitable preventative maintenance programs. Stainless steel stairs also require maintenance despite the impression given by its name.

Internal Stairs

Occasional cleaning to remove dirt is sufficient to maintain stairs in normal indoor situations.

External Stairs

enzie Powder-coated stairs used outdoors are subject to the same effects as other metal objects such as cars. For example dirt, tree sap, bird droppings, salt spray can cause damage to the surface. Prompt removal of these deposits will help to preserve the stair's finish. External stairs should be cleaned at least once per month and waxed two or three times per year.

Procedures

Cleaning: Make up a solution of mild detergent just as you would for cleaning your car. Wash thoroughly paying particular attention to removal of salt, dirt and other contaminants. Do not allow the solution to dry and rinse thoroughly with warm water.

Waxing: Apply a good quality automotive wax following the manufacturer's instructions.

Touch up: If paint is scratched or chipped, follow the cleaning procedure as previously described and then dry thoroughly. Then apply **enzie** touch up paint following the instruction on the pack.

Rust Treatment: If rust has already formed

1. Remove rust completely using sandpaper
2. Apply a rust converter. Fertan Rust Converter is a suitable product.
3. Apply a rust preventative primer. EPIGLASS PA 10 is a suitable product.
4. Apply touch up paint.

Each of these products should be applied as per the manufacturers recommended procedures.

External Stainless Steel Stairs: Stainless Steel is subject to corrosion and red rust can appear, due to the effect of salt (chlorine), particularly in marine areas. Once tarnishing has appeared, it can be removed by mechanical or chemical cleaning. Please call **enzie** stairs for detailed advice. However the best cure is preventative maintenance.

Stainless steel stairs should be cleaned in the same manner as described for powder coated stairs, with particular attention needed to remove contamination from all crevices. (Please note – stainless steel should not be waxed).
